<p>Sugar Maple <i>Acer saccharum</i> Produces sugar maple sap Brilliant fall colors</p> 	<p>Pawpaw (set of 2) <i>Asimina triloba</i> Delicious yellow fruit Two recommended for pollination</p> 	<p>Fragrant Sumac <i>Rhus aromatica</i> Flowers in April, Fall colors Attracts pollinators, erosion control</p> 
<p>Bur Oak <i>Quercus macrocarpa</i> Slow growing, wet or dry soils. Largest acorns & leaves of all oaks</p> 	<p>American Filbert (Hazelnut) <i>Corylus americana</i> Forms rounded thickets Provides tasty nuts</p> 	<p>Spicebush <i>Lindera benzoin</i> Broad, rounded shrub Fragrant yellow-green flowers</p> 
<p>American Sycamore <i>Platanus occidentalis</i> Large tree, exfoliating brown bark to reveal white inner bark Important riparian tree</p> 	<p>Clethra Ruby Spice <i>Clethra alnifolia</i> Summer fragrant pink flower Attracts pollinators Lovely yellow fall color</p> 	<p>Oakleaf Hydrangea 'Alice' <i>Hydrangea quercifolia 'Alice'</i> White flowers fading to pink Oak leaf shaped leaves turn maroon in fall</p> 
<p>Red Maple 'October Glory' <i>Acer rubrum-native cultivar</i> Broad oval crown Glossy foliage Crimson red late into the fall</p> 	<p>Elderberry <i>Sambucus canadensis</i> Edible, flowering Attracts pollinators Black elderberry fruits</p> 	<p>Saskatoon Serviceberry <i>Amelanchier alnifolia</i> Flowering, edible Attracts pollinators, easy to grow Beautiful shrub, purple berries</p> 

CONTAINER BLUEBERRY BUSHES - Group of (3) 2-year in 1 gallon pots

Duke: Early ripening northern variety. Blooms late, but ripens early. Very large fruit. 
Blue Ray: Mid-summer variety. High quality berries with outstanding dessert flavor.
Nelson: Late season harvest. Cross of Bluecrop and Berkeley variety. Firm berries. Good shelf life.

<p>Concolor Fir <i>Abies concolor</i> Needles soft to touch Ashy gray trunk, soft silvery blue foliage, used as Christmas tree</p>  10 pack	<p>White Pine <i>Pinus strobus</i> Long, soft needles Commonly used as Christmas trees Fast-growing evergreen</p>  10 pack	<p>Norway Spruce <i>Picea abies</i> Fast-growing spruce Branches droop as tree matures Windbreak/wildlife shelter</p>  10 pack
